Plan for Harvest Shares 2008

\$275 Founding member—harvest 2008 (purchased before January 2008)

\$300 Founding member—harvest 2008 (purchased January through June 2008)

What you can expect with your share in 2008

\$50 Credit for the 2009 harvest

Weekly shares to be picked up July 12- Sept 27 (12 weeks) including each week enough veggies for 3-5 dishes to feed a family of 4 including several of the following grown locally *without* synthetic fertilizer, pesticide or herbicide:

tomatoes, peppers, herbs, squash, carrots, onions, greens for cooking and salads, cukes, melons, broccoli, cauliflower, cabbage, potatoes, sweet corn, popcorn, fresh beans, peas, edible and cut flowers.

Accounting

Checks are made out to Work in Beauty, Inc., a non-profit organization in Gallup, NM. The CSA is not yet formally organized but is a project of Work in Beauty, Inc. Your expense for the season-share is not tax deductible because you will receive goods in exchange for it. The paper trail for your contribution includes a receipt for you to keep and a share card on file with the CSA. The share card will maintain a running record of your contributions and shares picked up.
